THE AMAZON HEALTH ROUTE AND CLIMATE CHANGE

The project aims to identify how climate change affects the health of Indigenous Peoples (Kraho and Gavião), through an analysis of challenges, perceptions, knowledge and best local practices. Promoting dialogues and adaptation measures that contribute to the improvement of the health of the Indigenous Peoples. Finally, it provides visibility and disseminates the results obtained and lessons learned with the purposes of mobilizing actions and proposing policies benefiting the health of the Indigenous Peoples' groups.



FEMINIST FUTURES

The initiative Our Feminist Futures connects young leaders across Brazil, fostering dialogue among racialized groups, traditional and local communities, and urban peripheries. It advocates for inclusive public policies and increased funding for women-led climate initiatives. By bringing together diverse communities and promoting intergenerational dialogue, the network strengthens young women's leadership in climate action. It also highlights women-led initiatives in the care economy and just transition, securing their essential role in building a sustainable future.

VOICES FOR JUST CLIMATE ACTION (VCA)

Through the VCA program, Hivos empowers more than 40 civil society organizations including Indigenous peoples, quilombolas, traditional and local communities to lead the fight against climate change. We work to amplify their voices in national and global arenas, ensuring that their knowledge and resilience are central to design inclusive climate solutions. By building strategic alliances with activists and frontrunners nationally, we provide these communities with the platforms and resources they need to influence climate policies and shape sustainable, just futures.



GLOBAL GIRLS CREATING CHANGE (G2C2)

The G2C2 project focuses on empowering young women and girls in Brazil, Indonesia, Uganda, and Nepal as key actors in climate action. Through leadership development, advocacy training, and the creation of safe spaces for collaboration, G2C2 amplifies the voices of young female leaders in the climate justice movement. We connect their local efforts to international platforms, working towards a common agenda leading up to COP30 and leveraging their innovative ideas to create a just and equitable response to the climate crisis.
